TASTING NOTES

An elegant expression displaying flavors of exotic tart red fruits erupting with pungent citrus notes. Pomegranate, raspberry, & kumquat flavors add equilibrium to refreshing aromas of dragonfruit & yuzu. Dry, versatile, & complex.

WINEGROWING

Grown with a focus on sustainability. These grapes are farmed on alluvial soils mixed with larger volcanic strata. A properly managed, umbrella like canopy allows for just the right air flow and dappled sunlight on to the clusters to achieve maximum quality. The soils of the vineyard site enhances the expression of character for each variety and lends to the uniqueness of the wine.

WINEMAKING

A saignée cuvée on all of our premium red vitis vinifera varietals. We pull this juice away from our red wine ferments to further concentrate them but end up with a beautiful rosé wine more akin to the Tavel style. Fermented and aged in stainless steel to maintain a mouthwatering acidity.
